


Research a Psychiatric Disorder

Method #1: Global Search Box – From the Psychiatryonline.org home page, enter your search term in the search box.


Method #2: Advanced and Citation Search - Users can easily choose between journal and book results using the Advanced Search box located under the search box. Within journal or book results, users can limit their search to any book or any journal by using the search filters within the Publications field.

The process of DSM-5 differential diagnosis can be broken down into six basic steps: 1) ruling out Malingering and Factitious Disorder, 2) ruling out a substance etiology, 3) ruling out an etiological medical condition, 4) determining the specific primary disorder(s), 5) differentiating Adjustment Disorder from the residual Other Specified and Unspecified conditions, and 6) establishing the boundary with no mental disorder. A thorough review of this chapter provides a useful framework for understanding and applying the decision trees presented in the next chapter.




- Have a “My POL” account.

If you do not have a “My POL” account, you can create one by clicking the “Register” link at the top of the Psychiatryonline homepage.


- I. From the **desktop** computer:
 - Visit: <http://psychiatryonline.org/pairdevice>
 - Write down the 6 character code that appears on your screen
- II. From your mobile device’s browser, go <http://psychiatryonline.org>
 - Log in to your “My POL” account.



Note: If you are using a tablet device and do not see the above screens, select the “View Mobile Site” button:



- Return to the **My Account** page, and select “Pair Device.” Enter the code you noted earlier, and click “Verify Code.”



- You will receive a message stating that you have successfully paired your device. Pairing lasts for 90 days, and allows access to Psychiatryonline from anywhere that has Internet access. After 90 days, you must repeat steps I and II above to re-pair your device.
